Dear Prime Minister,

RE: Voice to Parliament

I write on behalf of the Board of Directors of Communications Alliance Ltd, in relation to the proposed Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island **Voice to Parliament**.

During the most recent Communications Alliance Board Meeting, Directors considered the proposal for a referendum in 2023 to allow Australians to decide whether to amend the Australian Constitution to establish a Voice.

The Communications Alliance Board resolved unanimously that: "A Voice to Parliament is a reasonable and practical step for Australia to take, and is only achievable via a referendum."

The Board also decided to communicate this view to you, as Prime Minister, to other Federal Government Ministers and stakeholders and to other parliamentary parties.

I hope this information and viewpoint is useful. We will pay attention to developments throughout the course of 2023, as this important process plays out and will stay in touch with our portfolio Minister, The Hon. Michelle Rowland MP and other Ministers, as may be appropriate, on associated issues.

Many of our members are also looking at ways in which they can communicate and disseminate relevant material to their staff members. Some also have internal processes which they can use to consult with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander staff – others are looking at how to achieve this.
